## High Country

### Top 10 Plant

“Where People who Love to Garden, Love to Shop!”™

The list below are those plants that have proven themselves over the years. Each will take the Spring winds, Winter cold and perform well in our granite to clay soils. These are not the only plant found at the garden center, and some will only be available seasonally. As with any planting remember the 4-Rules of mountain planting. **Rule 1** - Dig the hole three times the width of the root ball. **Rule 2** - Mix 1/3 mulch to 2/3 native soil and throw out all rocks. **Rule 3** - Feed the first three months with fertilome 'Start-N-Grow'. **Rule 4** - Water completely with fertilome 'Root Stimulator' at least 3 time the first growing season.
