



Watering Guide

Water newly planted trees & shrubs

regularly with a garden hose for at least one month (2 months in Summer). Automatic irrigation systems may not be sufficient initially. Water frequency will vary according to season, exposure and plant size. Below is the recommended water guide during the growing season and then winters. We suggest taping this inside your irrigation box as a seasonal reminder.

| | Summer April - Oct | Winter Nov - Mar |
|----------------------------|-----------------------|---------------------|
| Established Plants | 1 X weekly | 2 X monthly |
| New Plantings | 2 X weekly | 2 X monthly |
| Lawns | 2 X weekly | 3 X monthly |
| Flowers, Herbs, Veggies | 3 X weekly | 3 X monthly |



Drip irrigation times are meant to run 2-3 hours. Additional water is needed for new plants or unusually dry weather.

Best taped inside irrigation box

Proper watering is the hardest part of growing plants. If your plants show signs of water stress, bring a sample branch into the garden center for diagnosis. Plants always benefit from a dose of granular '**Soil Activator**' to stabilize trauma and promote new root growth.
