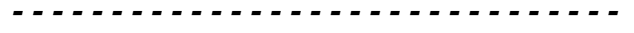




Watering Guidelines

Water newly planted trees and shrubs regularly with a garden hose for at least one month (2 months in Summer). Automatic irrigation systems may not be sufficient initially. Water frequency will vary according to season, exposure and plant size.



WATTERS MILE HIGH WATERING

	Summer April - Oct	Winter Nov - Mar
Established Plants	1 X weekly	2 X monthly
New Plantings	2 X weekly	2 X monthly
Lawns	2 X weekly	3 X monthly
Flowers, Herbs, Veggies	3 X weekly	3 X monthly

Drip irrigation times are meant to run 2-3 hours. Additional water is needed for new plants or unusually dry weather.
